

# A Voice for Coal: How to Help



**Q. How does ACT Online work?**

**A. It's simple. Invite Coal Show attendees to click on one of the three online letters/petitions available on the Bluefield web page. Online activists will then be taken to a pre-populated letter they can send to their elected officials or they can type in their own message and subject line.**

**Q. How do supporters send their letter?**

**A. To make sure their letter or petition signature is sent, all our supporters need to do is fill in all information boxes marked with a \*. It is critical that all of this information is included. The program will not send letters until all required information is entered.**

Once that information is entered, simply hit "send message" or "sign petition." That's it.

**Q. Is there anything else I should know?**

**A. At the bottom of our online letters is a check-marked box called "sign me up for the Action E-List." Please encourage our online supporters to leave the box checked. This will help them receive the latest information on important coal and mining news from Washington, D.C., and enable them to remain active online mining supporters.**

**Q. Is that it?**

**A. Not quite. Ask all attendees to send additional letters on behalf of all voting members of their families. Remember we need as many letters as possible to make a difference. Only then give them an "I've Been Heard" sticker.**
